

KEN HOWARD WINS EMMY FOR BEST SUPPORTING ACTOR

Ken Howard (Det. Bobby Ford in “THE BEACON”) took home the Emmy Sunday night for outstanding supporting actor in a made-for-television movie, “Grey Gardens.” The movie went on to pick up the top award in its category, and Jessica Lange also won for best actress.
